#### Medical Risk Profile

Order does not include a risk profile	<ul> <li>Order is silent on risk profile therefore no linkage to future Industry Health Standard which will sit separate to the order</li> <li>Inconsistent application of medical determinations against role profiles</li> </ul>	Include Risk Profile categories in new Order for low, medium, and high

Order does not include medical reviews	Employers are inconsistent in ensuring the completion of medical reviews	Include medical reviews in the Order and include payment for worker if it is for occupational exposure related

## Approved Medical Practitioner Governance

Order is silent on medical disclosures	<ul> <li>Order is silent on medical disclosures</li> <li>Clearly outlines what is released to the employer</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Include a schedule in the Order of Permitted Disclosures</li> <li>Name</li> <li>Date of Birth</li> <li>SEG</li> <li>Assessed risk category</li> <li>Overall Fitness for Role</li> <li>Restrictions / Remedial Actions</li> <li>Advise if disease, injury or illness as a result of work</li> <li>Follow up</li> <li>Corrective lenses / Hearing Aids</li> <li>Audiology results</li> <li>Equipment rating i.e. &gt; 120kg</li> </ul>

# Respirator Fit Testing (RFT)

<ul> <li>Preplacement Medical – RFT for a worker who will undertake tasks relating to production, processing or maintenance at a coal mine for the first time</li> </ul>	Replicated in Work Health and Safety Regulation 2017 – <u>REG 44</u>	RFT to be optional for employers
Periodic Medical – RFT with each medical		

# Medical Assessment – delays



Current	Issue / Enhancement	Opportunity
Order is silent on delays with part of the assessment	Order is silent on delays with part of the assessment	<ul> <li>Include a section that if the approved medical practitioner considers the risk to any coal mine worker from delaying an examination to be lower than the risk to the coal mine worker undergoing the examination of an adverse health effect of the examination i.e. chest x-ray and pregnancy</li> </ul>

Submitted to CS Health on 31     October each calendar year	<ul> <li>Requesting information in the last quarter of the year</li> <li>Provides data back earlier to industry for the forthcoming year planning</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Change submission date to 30         September each calendar year</li> <li>Include commencement date,         termination date, SEG and role</li> </ul>

#### **Approved Health Professionals**



Current	Issue / Enhancement	Opportunity
<ul> <li>Only Registered Nurses can provide Order 43 medical services under the supervision of an Approved Medical Practitioner</li> </ul>	Limits the scope of health professionals available to be used to complete medical assessments especially by the External Doctor Network	<ul> <li>Increase the scope of approved health professionals to include</li> <li>Registered Nurses</li> <li>Accredited Exercise         <ul> <li>Physiologists</li> <li>Occupational Therapists</li> <li>Physiotherapist</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
